Orchestra is 100% solution –dyed acrylic with the NEW sunacryl rot-proof fibres and is finished with a Cleangard treatment.

SUNACRYL: A solution-dyed fibre specially selected for Dickson Constant, which gives the canvases colour-retaining qualities, allowing them to breathe and resist water. Canvases woven with SUNACRYL, subjected to more than 1000 hours of an alternating programme of sunlight and sprinkling reproducing extreme meteorological conditions, still retain their bright colours.

CLEANGARD: A new generation treatment for awning fabric, Cleangard uses an ultra modern procedure to protect outdoor fabric: the NPP (Nanotechnology Protection Process). This state of the art technology, based on an assembly of extremely dense nano-molecules, creates a real barrier against water and repels the dirt long term. The Cleangard treatment brings to Dickson awning fabric a maximum water repellence (5/5 spray test) and an exceptional water resistance (350mm on the water column test).

Dickson Orchestra fabric is backed by a 5 year guarantee

Colour fastness to UV light:

General maintenance:

All awning fabrics require regular cleaning in order to maintain optimal appearance and prolong the life of the awning. For general cleaning use a soft brush to remove any dust and dry soil.

If necessary you can use **303 Fabric Cleaner** or **303 Spot removers** for those hard to remove or unknown stains. Rinse with water and leave to dry naturally before rolling up.



Customer Information:

In choosing a Dickson fabric for your awning, you have opted top quality. Automation, permanent checks, laboratory tests, elaborate finishing treatment....Nothing is left to chance. This way, we can guarantee the resistance, strength and durability of the colours of your awning fabrics.

Our fabrics, woven from solution-dyed SUNACRYL acrylic fibre for top quality, benefit from all the attention that we pay to their preparation and manufacture.

However it could happen that you note some minor imperfections after fitting your blind. A slight embossing, some veining, small folds along the stitching, in the centre of the fabrics or possibly some overlapping could appear.

These hardly perceptible irregularities are inherent in the nature of acrylic fibre and have no effect on the performance of your canvas.

So your fitter can in no way be held responsible for these slight imperfections. Fabrics treated with resins containing fluoride may present "veining" visible against the sunlight and due to an optical effect (difference in the refraction of light).
